



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall was born in Loveland, Colorado on September 1, 1966 and moved to Carson City, Nevada in 1983; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall began her career in State Service in Carson City as an Accounting Clerk Trainee for the Employment Security Department in 1990; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall within weeks of her appointment, promoted to an Accounting Clerk I, processing Travel and Accounts Payable in the Employment Security Department's Financial Management; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall promoted to an Accounting Clerk II in the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation, Employment Security Division processing purchase orders credit receipts and reconciling the revolving fund for the Blind Enterprise Program; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall accepted a promotion in 1997 to an Accounting Specialist with Child and Family Services Division of the Department of Health and Human Services. Specifically working with eligibility payments for foster care and Medicaid eligibility for state reimbursements from the Social Security Insurance & Social Security Administration trust accounts. Cynthia also became a financial liaison for the development of the Statewide Child Welfare Information System in use today; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall promoted in 2001 to an Account Technician I with the Taxation Department reconciling county reimbursements; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall six weeks later promoted to an Accountant Technician II with the Welfare Division, returning to the Department of Health and Human Services. This promotion was specific to setting up the State Collection and Disbursements for child support statewide and participated in the cost benefit analysis of NOMADS; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall in 2003 promoted to an Accountant I in the Welfare Division, managing contracts, reconciling Health and Human Services grants and was a member of the cost allocation team; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall promoted in 2006 to a Management Analyst II with the Department of Public Safety, Nevada Highway Patrol to manage contracts and soon after was requested to take the role of the Grants and Projects Analyst to manage the Motor Carrier Safety Alliance Program grant funding and write the Commercial Vehicle Safety Plan; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall oversaw various law enforcements grants in 2009, and in 2012, she was offered the fiscal oversight to manage the largest budget of the Nevada Highway Patrol until her retirement date of July 13, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Cynthia Macall's outstanding efforts and professional demeanor have benefitted the Nevada Highway Patrol and the Department of Public Safety, as well as the citizens of the State of Nevada; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim July 13, 2015 as a day in honor of
