WHEREAS, Charles Allen was hired as a Cadet on August 6, 1990 with the Nevada Highway Patrol; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Charles "Chuck" Allen graduated from Academy XXVI on January 4, 1991 and was assigned to Lovelock, Nevada as a Traffic Officer; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Chuck Allen transferred from Lovelock to Reno, Nevada Traffic Operations in October, 1992 upon completion of his FTO Training; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Chuck Allen was reassigned and served in the Dignitary Protection Detail for Governor Bob Miller from October, 1995 to February, 1997; and

WHEREAS, from February 1997 to August 2003, Trooper Chuck Allen served in various capacities with the Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Chuck Allen was a member of the NHP Honor Guard for ten years from January, 1997 to February, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Chuck Allen was reassigned from Background Investigations in October, 2003 to the Public Information Officer (PIO) for the Nevada Highway Patrol, until his retirement on January 4, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Chuck Allen was then elected as the 26th Sheriff of Washoe County on November 4, 2014; and


