**WHEREAS**, Brian David Sanchez became employed with the Nevada Highway Patrol on August 6, 1990 and was assigned to the Reno Duty Station as a Trooper in Traffic Operations on January 4, 1991; and

**WHEREAS**, Trooper Brian Sanchez was promoted to Sergeant in Commercial Operations and assigned to Northern Command West on October 5, 1998; and

**WHEREAS**, Sergeant Brian Sanchez was transferred from Northern Command West to the Department of Public Safety Training Division on November 12, 2002 and was promoted to Lieutenant, assigned to the Department of Public Safety Training Academy; and

**WHEREAS**, Lieutenant Brian Sanchez served in many capacities and was promoted to Captain, and transferred to Las Vegas, Southern Command, on December 5, 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, In December of 2006, Captain Brian Sanchez was promoted to Major and transferred from Las Vegas, Southern Command, to Headquarters, in Carson City, until November 2014 when he was appointed to Lieutenant Colonel; and

**WHEREAS**, Lieutenant Colonel Brian Sanchez has unselfishly dedicated 25 years of professional law enforcement service to the Department of Public Safety, Nevada Highway Patrol, and to the citizens of the State of Nevada;
