



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, people of all ages and walks of life, across America and around the world, collectively witnessed an event of immense tragedy on September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the events of that day instantly transformed nearly everyone's lives, some through personal loss, and many others through an unfamiliar sense of individual and national vulnerability; and

WHEREAS, September 11 will never, and should never, be just another day in the hearts and minds of all Americans and people around the world; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States, on September 11, 2009, issued the Patriot Day Proclamation officially and permanently designating September 11 as a National Day of Service and Remembrance, and calling upon all interested Americans to participate in this observance through moments of silence, the flying of the flag of the United States at half-staff, as well as community service and charitable activities in tribute and remembrance; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Volunteers, as the Governors Commission on Service, works to expand Nevada's ethic of service, a hallmark of the Nevadan character, through expansion of service opportunities through National Service day events; and

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2015, Nevada Volunteers staff, and AmeriCorps*Nebraska members and staff, along with veterans throughout the state, will engage in service projects led collaboratively by Nevada Volunteers and Truckee Meadows Parks Foundation in partnership with the City of Sparks and The Outside Las Vegas Foundation in partnership with the City of North Las Vegas to beautify our communities to honor the sacrifice of those who lost their lives on September 11, 2001, or who rose in service as a result of that tragedy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim September 11, 2015 as
