WHEREAS, the State of Nevada recognizes the dedication and vital role of Direct Support Professionals in enhancing the lives of individuals with disabilities of all ages and appreciates the contribution of Direct Support Professionals in supporting the needs that reach beyond the capacities of thousands of families in Nevada; and
