WHEREAS, Nevada Department of Transportation road maintenance employee Ron Raiche, Jr. lost his life on March 30, 2015 after being struck by a vehicle while making important roadside repairs to Interstate 80 near Battle Mountain; and

WHEREAS, Ron proudly served as NDOT Highway Maintenance Worker II in Battle Mountain, helping preserve the safety and mobility of state roads for the traveling public, as well as maintaining the state's important transportation public infrastructure investment; and

WHEREAS, Ron has left a legacy of dedication to workplace safety and improved state roads to his Nevada Department of Transportation team members, his community of Battle Mountain and to the citizens of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, Ron Raiche, Jr. will be remembered as a dedicated public servant, tirelessly pursuing the absolute best in all of his job duties; and

WHEREAS, Ron will sincerely be missed, both personally and professionally, by all those who had opportunity to know and work with him; and

WHEREAS, Ron became the 24th Nevada Department of Transportation employee to tragically lose their life in the line of service since 1948; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Department of Transportation and partner agencies call on all motorists to drive safely, slow down and pay attention in road work zones, for their own safety and for the safety of everyone working on the road; and

WHEREAS, a memorial star will be dedicated on NDOT's workers memorial in Ron's memory;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim September 14, 2015 as a day in honor of

RON RAICHE, JR.
