WHEREAS, Troy Dillard has been instrumental in facilitating service improvements and pioneering new programs and innovative uses of modern technology to enhance customer experiences; and

WHEREAS, Troy Dillard was responsible for restructuring the administration of Nevada's vehicle emissions program, resulting in significant savings to Nevada motorists each year; and

WHEREAS, Troy Dillard's tenure as Director of the DMV reflects an outstanding commitment to promoting an efficient and responsive state government that meets the needs of Nevada's citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles and the entire State of Nevada join with colleagues and management to express our profound and sincere appreciation to Troy Dillard for his 30 years of dedicated public service and leadership, and to extend our best wishes to him for a happy and fulfilling retirement;
