



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, the Clark County Sanitation District Number 1 was formed in 1954, and a wastewater facility to serve the sanitation needs of the unincorporated Las Vegas Valley began operations in 1956; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Sanitation District changed its name to the Water Reclamation District to better reflect the important role it plays in the water care cycle, with oversight and management responsibilities for more than 2,000 miles of pipelines and seven treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Flamingo Water Resource Center is the largest wastewater treatment facility in the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Water Reclamation District continues to invest in the community and its infrastructure by ensuring that water is safe and suitable for continued use as the most precious resource for our community and our environment; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Water Reclamation District's mission is to serve the community by responsibly sustaining the water care cycle, and the men and women of the Clean Water Team work every day to protect the community's resources and the health and safety of Nevada's citizens; and

WHEREAS, this month marks the beginning of 60 years of the Reclamation District's efficient wastewater treatment and returning safe, clean, and usable water to communities across Clark County; and

WHEREAS, the effective use, management, conservation, and preservation of Nevada's water resources, particularly during the current period of prolonged drought in the Western United States, remains a critical objective of state government that is fundamental to Nevada's future economic growth and sustainability;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim November 14, 2015, as a day in honor of the
