



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 176 was passed by the Nevada State Legislature and signed into law on May 29, 2015, establishing the Nevada Yellow Dot Program; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC), in partnership with local jurisdictions, law enforcement, and fire and rescue agencies, has taken responsibility for implementing and administering the Nevada Yellow Dot Program in Southern Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Yellow Dot Program is designed to assist emergency personnel in responding to traffic incidences by immediately providing them with a Yellow Dot Program participant's medical information when they may be unable to do so; and

WHEREAS, the expanded access to medical information made possible by the Nevada Yellow Dot Program will significantly aid in providing proper medical attention to program participants during the critical moments immediately after an incident; and

WHEREAS, the Yellow Dot Program has already been successfully implemented in 22 other states; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Yellow Dot Program is aligned with Nevada's strategic goal of ensuring safe and livable communities by improving the ability of emergency personnel and first responders to access lifesaving information during an emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim the month of December, 2015 as

YELLOW DOT MONTH IN NEVADA
