



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Scott Rasmussen will retire from the Nevada Division of Forestry on December 31, 2015, after twenty-one years of loyal public service to the citizens of the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, Scott Rasmussen began his career in wildland firefighting as a member of the volunteer fire department in Washoe Valley, later joining the Nevada Division of Forestry as a Conservation Crew Supervisor, rising through the ranks first as a Firefighter and subsequently as a Fire Captain; and

WHEREAS, Scott Rasmussen took a short break in service to work as a Fire Station Captain for Douglas County, thereafter returning to the Nevada Division of Forestry as a Battalion Chief, and finally Fire Management Program Manager; and

WHEREAS, Scott Rasmussen has served in various capacities and multiple assignments on national Incident Management Teams throughout his career, as part of the State of Nevada's mutual aid agreements with other states; and

WHEREAS, Scott Rasmussen has devoted his talents to keeping Nevada safe under four Governors, including Governors Bob Miller, Kenny Guinn, Jim Gibbons and Governor Brian Sandoval; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada joins Scott Rasmussen's colleagues and friends in extending gratitude and appreciation to Scott for his twenty-one years of devoted and honorable service to the State, with best wishes for success during his retirement and future endeavors;
