WHEREAS, internal auditing is an independent, objective assurance or consulting function that is insightful, proactive, and future-focused, adding value to both public and private sector organizations and helping them to achieve their goals; and

WHEREAS, the Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA) is a global professional association and standard-setting body for internal auditors whose mission is to provide dynamic leadership for the global profession of internal auditing; and

WHEREAS, the IIA serves as the world's leader in professional certification, education, research, and technical guidance for internal auditors, with more than 180,000 members and representation from over 170 countries, including 160 chapters worldwide and two IIA chapters in Nevada; and

WHEREAS, governance groups and senior management rely on Internal Audit for insight and objective assurance that existing internal controls are adequate to mitigate organizational risks, that governance and risk management processes are effective and efficient, and organizational goals and strategic objectives are met; and
