



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada is committed to facilitating and promoting economic development projects, including projects that create jobs and diversify the economy, both in rural counties and throughout the entire state; and

WHEREAS, the Hawthorne Army Depot, SOC-USA and Mineral County Economic Development Authority, in partnership with the Armament and Retooling Support (ARMS) Program, have achieved Nevada Certified Economic Development Site Status; and

WHEREAS, the United States Army has affirmed that the Certified Site Program is essential to marketing and promoting the ARMS Program; and

WHEREAS, encouraging commercialization of property within the Hawthorne Army Depot boundaries supports development of important, "shovel-ready" industrial and commercial sites which will ultimately result in new investments, economic growth, and job creation for the county; and
