



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Kendall Cummings began his employment with the State of Nevada, Department of Public Safety, Division of Parole and Probation on April 24, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Officer Cummings worked diligently and was promoted first to the rank of Sergeant and then to Department of Public Safety Lieutenant, where he served for a year at Headquarters in Carson City; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Cummings worked in multiple areas of operations within the Parole and Probation division, including General Supervision, House Arrest, Intensive Supervision, Drug Court and Presentence Investigations; and
