



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, the week in which Labor Day falls is an opportunity to raise awareness and pay tribute to more than 150 million people who work in the United States and the payroll professionals who support the American system by paying wages, reporting worker earnings and withholding federal employment taxes; and

WHEREAS, payroll professionals in the Silver State play a key role in maintaining the economic health of Nevada, carrying out tasks such as paying into the unemployment insurance system, providing information for child support enforcement, and carrying out tax withholding, reporting and depositing; and
