



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Bob Ferraro served on the Boulder City Council for 31 years, including six separate stints as mayor; and

WHEREAS, Bob is a Nevada native, born into a family of ranchers in Winnemucca on July 30, 1935; and

WHEREAS, he grew up in the tiny town of Paradise Valley, about 40 miles north of Winnemucca, where he was educated in a three-room schoolhouse and was all by himself in grades 2-6; and

WHEREAS, he worked for the agriculture department at the University of Nevada, Reno until January 1970 and then went to work as a chemical engineer at the American Pacific plant in Henderson; and

WHEREAS, Ferraro retired from American Pacific in 2000 and left government service in 2007; and


WHEREAS, Bob will be honored for his lifetime of devoted service to the community of Boulder City on April 12, 2013;
