**WHEREAS**, we can all help save someone's life and benefit another 50 recipients by registering as an organ and tissue donor on the Nevada Donor Registry when we apply for or renew our driver's license or directly online at [DonateLifeNevada.org](http://DonateLifeNevada.org); and

**WHEREAS**, this observance pays tribute to organ and tissue donors and their families whose decision to Donate Life enables others to receive life-saving organs and tissues for transplant; and

**WHEREAS**, donations save lives and recipients and their families give heartfelt thanks to the donors and their families for "Giving the Gift of Life" during a most difficult time in their own lives;
