**WHEREAS**, after 14 years of dedicated service to the Reno-Tahoe region, Krys T. Bart is retiring from the Reno-Tahoe International Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, her friends, family and colleagues wish her a fulfilling retirement and thank her for a job well done;
