



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, with the settlement of Carson City came residential and business structures and with those structures came danger from fire; and

WHEREAS, Warren Engine Co. No. 1 was organized in Carson City, Nevada Territory on June 17, 1863, for the purpose of protecting the lives and property of the people of that community; and

WHEREAS, Warren Engine Co. No. 1 has always lived up to its motto of "Where Duty Calls, There You'll Find Us," by fearlessly and faithfully responding to and battling fires that have threatened Carson City and its residents since 1863; and

WHEREAS, Warren Engine Co. No. 1 has always had a strong sense of community, taking the lead in and contributing to public service projects too numerous to list but including the construction of the youth athletic field known as Governor's Field; creation of the Carson City Fire Department with a career staff and chief officers; funding for construction of a firehouse and new fire equipment for Carson City; Christmas baskets for needy families; purchase of bonds in two world wars; construction and maintenance of the Nevada Firefighters' Memorial, and many other community projects; and

WHEREAS, Warren Engine Co. No. 1 was the first fire company in Carson City and survived three other rival companies, and is one of the oldest continuously operating fire departments on the West Coast, and

WHEREAS, the spirit of volunteerism, community service and pride that have marked the service of Warren Engine Co. No. 1 for 150 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim June 17, 2013 as
