Department and at various times, he has served as a Nevada Licensed Substitute Teacher, as Vice President and Treasurer of the Douglas High School Booster Club, a CASA Advisory Board Member, a Fighting Chance Instructor, GREAT Instructor and a Douglas County Sheriff's Explorer Advisor; and

WHEREAS, Chris is a Member of the Orange County Dare Officer Association, the Southern California's Juvenile Officers Association Board Member, a Member of the Nevada DARE Officers Association and currently serves as Nevada's DARE Officer Representative; and

WHEREAS, Chris is currently a mentor to his Partner, husband to Yvette Griffith, a father and a grandfather;
