



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, the United States Mint America the Beautiful Quarters® Program, created by Public Law 110-456, produces circulating quarters emblematic of a national park or other site in each state, the District of Columbia and five U.S. territories; and

WHEREAS, the Great Basin National Park quarter is the eighteenth released into circulation as part of the program; and

WHEREAS, Nevada is home to a community of dedicated teachers who will recognize the release of the Great Basin National Park quarter as an opportunity to bring further knowledge and appreciation of the site into the classroom; and

WHEREAS, the America the Beautiful Quarters Program features on-line lesson plans with a series of interactive and educational tools for students in kindergarten through high school found at www.usmint.gov; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. (PT), a ceremony will be held at the Great Basin National Park Visitor Center in Baker, Nevada to commemorate the release of the Great Basin National Park quarter into circulation;
