



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Todd William Ellison was hired as a Cadet #488 on September 16, 1985 with the Nevada Highway Patrol; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Todd W. Ellison graduated from Academy XXI on January 21, 1986 and was assigned to Las Vegas, Nevada as a Commercial Enforcement Officer #235; and

WHEREAS, Commercial Officer Todd W. Ellison transferred from Las Vegas to Reno, Nevada as a Trooper on November 30, 1987, and assigned to the Hazardous Material Response Team, Commercial Enforcement, and Governors Protective Detail; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Todd W. Ellison was assigned to the Criminal Interdiction Team and as a member of the Consolidated Narcotics Unit; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Todd W. Ellison was promoted to Sergeant on October 19, 1992 and transferred from Reno to Winnemucca, Nevada, Traffic Operations; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Todd W. Ellison promoted to Lieutenant on September 9, 1995 and reassigned to Las Vegas, Nevada and served as the Deputy Commander of Commercial Enforcement, Criminal Interdiction, Traffic Operations and the Administrative Operations; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Todd W. Ellison was promoted to Captain on April 17, 2003 and remained in Las Vegas, Nevada and served as the Commander of Operations and Administrative Services; and

WHEREAS, Captain Todd W. Ellison was promoted to Lieutenant Colonel on July 1, 2011 and transferred from Las Vegas to Carson City, Nevada and assumed Command of statewide Operations; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Todd W. Ellison was nominated on November 6, 2013 as Vice-Chair of the International Associations of Chiefs of Police, Homeland Security Committee, and is the senior member of the Nevada Highway Patrol at the time of his retirement from the Department of Public Safety on December 20, 2013; and


