WHEREAS, the mission of Nevada Project Heartbeat is to save lives through promotion of early defibrillation, education in sudden cardiac arrest, and promotion of training in AED/CPR, all for the citizens and visitors throughout the great state of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, public access defibrillation programs benefit all members of a community by empowering people to help people; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Project Heartbeat has implemented the HeartSafe Community program to recognize the collective efforts of agencies and organizations to enhance and improve their pre-hospital system, increase awareness of Sudden Cardiac Arrest, increase placements of automated external defibrillators and make their community a healthier place to live and visit; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Project Heartbeat has awarded the first HeartSafe Community designations to Incline Village and Crystal Bay under the leadership of North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District, Zephyr Cove, Stateline, and Glenbrook under the leadership of Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District, Carson Valley and Topaz under the leadership of East Fork Fire and Paramedic Districts, and Eureka County under the leadership of Eureka County Emergency Medical Services; and

WHEREAS, Nevada celebrates its 150th birthday in this year 2013 and Nevada Project Heartbeat is proud to be part of making Nevada a great place to live, visit and raise families;
