**WHEREAS**, the structural steel industry annually provides structural steel framing systems for more than 500 million square feet of new building construction throughout state name and other states; and

**WHEREAS**, the structural steel industry provides employment for more than 150,000 workers in state name and other states; and

**WHEREAS**, the structural steel industry has demonstrated a significant commitment to sustainable construction through the use of structural steel products made from 93% recycled materials from old cars, appliances, stoves, manufacturing waste, curb-side recycling and deconstructed buildings; and

**WHEREAS**, 98% of the structural steel in a building is recycled at the end of the building's life; and

**WHEREAS**, structural steel's high strength-to-weight ratio and low carbon footprint help to minimize environmental impacts; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Institute of Steel Construction has declared Friday, October 4, 2013 SteelDay throughout the United States with more than 150 events nationwide;
