Face coverings must be worn at private residential gatherings anytime you're with people outside of your household, even if you're socially distant.</i>
	Public Social Gatherings <i>As set forth in Directive 033 and for the purposes of this guidance, a "gathering" is defined as an activity that draws persons to: (1) the same space, (2) at the same time, (3) for the same purpose, and (4) for the same duration of time. This including, but is not limited to: Places of Worship, Indoor Movie Theaters, Live Theater Performances, Casino Showrooms, Event Venues, Trade Shows, Conferences, Conventions, Professional Seminars, Milestone Events, Weddings, Funerals, & Similar Gathering Activities.</i>	ALLOWED w. LIMITS	250 individuals or 50% capacity, whichever is less <i>Limited to no more than 250 individuals or 50 percent of fire code capacity, whichever is less, under strict social distancing requirements.</i> Gatherings, including Places of Worship: If fire code capacity is fewer than 100 persons, services may be conducted with up to 50 people if able to be conducted in a manner consistent with required social distancing, but in no instance may places of worship exceed their listed fire code capacity. Indoor Movie Theaters, Live Theater Performances, Casino Showrooms: Limited to no more than 250 individuals or 50 percent of fire code capacity, whichever is less, per each individual theater and screen, under strict social distancing requirements.	50 individuals or 25% capacity, whichever is less <i>Limited to no more than 50 individuals or 25 percent of fire code capacity, whichever is less, under strict social distancing requirements.</i> Gatherings, including Places of Worship: If fire code capacity is fewer than 200 persons, services may be conducted with up to 50 people if able to be conducted in a manner consistent with required social distancing, but in no instance may places of worship exceed their listed fire code capacity. Indoor Movie Theaters, Live Theater Performances, Casino Showrooms: Limited to no more than 50 individuals or 25 percent of fire code capacity, whichever is less, per each individual theater and screen, under strict social distancing requirements.

LIMITS	50% CAPACITY <i>May allow indoor/outdoor dining under strict social distancing requirements at NO MORE THAN 50% OCCUPANCY based on applicable fire code.</i> <i>No more than 6 patrons per table with social distancing requirements.</i>	25% CAPACITY <i>May allow indoor/outdoor dining under strict social distancing requirements at NO MORE THAN 25% OCCUPANCY based on applicable fire code.</i> Reservations Required for restaurants and bars, pubs, wineries and breweries that serve food. <i>No more than 4 patrons per table with social distancing requirements.</i> Face coverings must be worn at all times, except when actively eating or drinking, regardless of social distancing. <i>Strongly encouraged to continue curbside, delivery, and/or carry out operations.</i>

LIMITS	50% CAPACITY <i>May operate under strict social distancing requirements at NO MORE THAN 50% OCCUPANCY based on applicable fire code.</i> <i>Strongly encouraged to promote and continue online or call-in ordering, curbside, delivery, and/or carry out operations.</i> <i>Grocery stores: May not offer self-serve food options, like salad bars and unpackaged dry goods, nuts, seeds, coffee, etc.</i>	NO CAPACITY CHANGES (remains at 50% limit) NEW: Retail & grocery stores with over 50,000 sq. ft. capacity: - MUST have "counters" at all public entrances to manage capacity; and - Are encouraged to conduct temperature screenings before entry and, at a minimum, MUST have health screening signage at public entrances.
NO CHANGES	Offices	OPEN w. LIMITS	<i>Services should continue to be conducted virtually or by telephone whenever possible. Staff should be encouraged to continue to work from home as much as possible or return to work in phases. Work from home to the greatest extent possible and close offices to the public. Do not allow for congregation of employees in break rooms or conference/meeting rooms, including for meetings, retirements, birthdays, or other milestone celebrations.</i>	NO CHANGES
	Indoor Malls	OPEN w. LIMITS	50% CAPACITY <i>May operate under strict social distancing requirements at NO MORE THAN 50% OCCUPANCY based on applicable fire code -- including no more than 50% capacity within each individual retail store, which must comply with all the retail business restrictions.</i> <i>Strongly encouraged to promote and continue online or call-in ordering, curbside, delivery, and/or carry out operations.</i>	NO CHANGES
	Cannabis: Medicinal & Recreational Establishments	OPEN w. LIMITS	50% CAPACITY <i>May operate under strict social distancing requirements at NO MORE THAN 50% OCCUPANCY based on applicable fire code. Curbside sales, home delivery also allowed. Must follow expanded health and safety guidelines enforced by the NV Cannabis Compliance Board.</i>	NO CHANGES
	Hair Salons, Barbershops, Nail salons & Businesses that provide Aesthetic Skin Services	OPEN w. LIMITS	50% CAPACITY <i>Appointment only. Customers waiting for appointment must wait outside and practice social distancing. Salons & barber shops with walls/partitions between stations or chairs may utilize all stations, but no more than 1 customer can be at a station at any given time. Salons and barber shops without walls/partitions between stations/chairs may only seat clients every other station or chair, or arrange stations or chairs to a min of 6ft apart. Customers, stylists, technicians, barbers, and other employees must always wear face coverings.</i>	NO CHANGES

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N O C H A N G E S	Spas, Massage Therapy & Massage Establishments	OPEN w. LIMITS	<p>May operate under strict social distancing requirements per existing Directives and protocols established by Licensing boards. See Nevada State Board of Cosmetology and Nevada State Board of Massage Therapy</p> <p><i>Customers, clients, masseuses and other employees must wear face coverings. Services shall be provided by appointment only, and customers waiting for an appointment must wait outside and practice social distancing. Out-call and/or in-home service may be provided with observation of same protocols as in the establishments. Establishments, including day and overnight spas, that may operate for aesthetic and massage services must prohibit the use of steam rooms, saunas, portable saunas, vapor baths, salt therapy rooms, hot tubs, and any other communal facilities.</i></p>	NO CHANGES
	Body Art or Piercing Establishments	OPEN w. LIMITS	<p style="text-align: center;">50% CAPACITY</p> <p><i>Employees and customers must always wear face coverings. No body art or piercing may be done around the nose or mouth. Services shall be provided by appointment only, and customers waiting for an appointment must wait outside and practice social distancing. Establishments with walls/partitions between stations or chairs may utilize all stations, but no more than 1 customer can be at a station at any given time. Establishments without walls/partitions between stations/chairs may only seat clients every other station or chair, or arrange stations or chairs to a min of 6ft apart.</i></p>	NO CHANGES
	Community & Recreational Centers (including public pools)	OPEN w. LIMITS	<p style="text-align: center;">50% CAPACITY</p> <p><i>May operate under strict social distancing requirements at NO MORE THAN 50% OCCUPANCY based on applicable fire code. All interactive and/or hands-on exhibits must be closed.</i></p>	NO CHANGE

Face coverings/masks are required at every business, venue and gathering space (public or private).

Every business, venue and gathering space must follow all social distancing requirements and is required to post their capacity limit under COVID-19 directives and guidelines at all public entrances pursuant to Emergency Directive 033, Section 8.
