**COVID-19 Press Bulletin for 5-26-2021**

Carson City, NV — Today, Caleb Cage, Nevada COVID-19 Response Director and Karissa Loper, Bureau Chief for the Bureau of Child, Family, and Community Wellness provided updates on Nevada's ongoing COVID-19 response and vaccination efforts in Nevada during a call with members of the media.

**SUMMARY:**

- As of today, Nevada has logged 323,249 cases, with the 14-day rolling average of daily cases being 147.
- Nevada has now completed a total of 3,359,409 molecular tests since the beginning of COVID-19.
- The test positivity rate over the last 14 days is 4.3%.

- Today, the Nevada Hospital Association is reporting there are currently 257 COVID-19 hospitalizations (252 confirmed; 45 suspected)
- As of May 25, 2,212,493 COVID-19 vaccine doses (By Resident County) were administered and reported to Nevada WebIZ.
- More than 47% of the population 12 and older has initiated vaccination and 38.5% of the population 12 and older has completed vaccination.
- This weekend marked the last stop on the FEMA Mobile Vaccination Units.
- Since early April, the two mobile units visited many of Nevada's most rural and tribal communities, providing an opportunity for vaccination close to home.
- The events were very successful and ultimately reached individuals in 28 towns around Nevada.
