## Additional Requirements for Single Subject Music, Physics, Reading, and Speech Endorsements

- <u>Music (NAC 391.13105)</u>: A single subject endorsement in music can only be issued as a major and requires thirty (30) semester credits of specific coursework outlined in NAC 391.13105.
- <u>Speech and World Languages (NAC 391.1312)</u>: The credits required for a major in these endorsement areas must include fifteen (15) semester credits taken in upper-level courses. The credits required for a minor in these endorsement areas must include five (5) semester credits taken in upper-level courses.
- <u>Reading (NAC 391.1312)</u>: A single subject endorsement in reading, issued as a minor, must not include any semester credits in freshman English. Nine (9) of the required sixteen (16) semester credits for the minor in reading must include credits taken in upper-level courses.
